Wayne Jr describes a time around his salvation experience when he was feeling broken inside. This becomes key to how he gained clarity on what God calls him to do. Explain how brokenness has been instrumental to your understanding of calling & share it with the group. [If nothing immediately comes to mind, you may gain valuable insight by listening to others’ thoughts, then answering]

Wayne Jr. describes a time after his prayer for salvation when his some areas of his conduct had not changed—he was experiencing grief inside. Matthew 5:4 refers to grief that literally cannot be hidden; it is self-evident to an observer. Have you ever grieved the Holy Spirit in a way that others have called it to your notice? [be prepared to share with your group]

Wayne Jr’s reference to Matthew 5:5 “Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.” cannot be fully understood without considering Matthew 11:29 where Jesus describes Himself as meek and Numbers 12:3, where Moses was described as more meek “...than all people who were on the face of the earth. Neither leader could possibly be considered *weak*. Does the term “gentleness of strength” describe meekness in your mind? Share your thoughts with your group.

“If we are willing to surrender, how do we not spend time with Him, to seek His face every day?...If we’re here, bought with an incredible price, Him sacrificing His only Son, relieved from sin as our master...then how are we not asking: *What do you want me to do?*” Wayne Jr. How could you apply Wayne’s thoughts to your daily routine?

Wayne Jr. describes a very specific conversation when he and his wife committed to never allow career decisions to get in the way of their family. Is there anything that stands out to you regarding his commitment?

Wayne Jr tells the story of his 3-year struggle with permitting delays for Rybovich Yacht Basin’s improvements. He had openly professed that he believed the vision for his new venture came from the Lord. In the midst of those struggles, Wayne Sr asked him: “Are you sure you got the vision right?” Do you find that others question if your vision is from the Lord? ____ How do you respond to them?

When Rybovich finally launched, the grand opening was soon followed by the grand recession of 2008. Once the company stabilized, Wayne Jr started promoting servant leadership in the company, including formal training for him and 18 key leaders. What part of his story most stands out to you as an example of servant leadership?

Wayne Jr states that it’s harder to do life with integrity; but if you’re living with integrity you are thirsting for righteousness. He then quoted from a devotional that said “When we reach the point that we are becoming more and more one with God, our common sense decisions are actually God’s decisions; because our mind has learned to think like God thinks.” Do you agree or disagree with his statements?
